Programme

16th of July, Friday, Alfa Romeo fans meet at the appointed place near Palanga at **15:00 – 16:00 PM**. Meeting place will be announced on 12th of July (we have to get some permissions).

16th of July, Friday, at 17:00 PM, international Alfa caravan will enter Palanga with police escort. The caravan of expected 100 cars will drive through main streets of Palanga, stop and greet visitors in Vytautas street. Short greeting speeches by „Alfa Romeo“ representatives from Italy and local dealer and foreign club's introducing themselves.

At 18:00 PM police escorts the caravan to „Alfa Romeo city“, established near 1000 km racing circuit. City will consist of „Alfa Romeo“ parking, tent area, stage, food zone, WC, seats for watching race, big tent from rain. Only members of „Alfa Romeo“ club and invited guests will be allowed to enter the guarded area with special ids. In the evening dealers, „Alfa Romeo“ factory reps, Alfa Racing teams joins the crowd.

At 20:00 PM first stage of „Alfa Party“ will start – the moderator will heat the crowd, DJ will play the music.

17th of July, Saturday, is racing day. Everyone watches and supports at least 3 „Alfa Romeo“ cars participating in the race (Alfa Club Racing Team among them). The race schedule:

- 10:00 AM: Cars are headed to „Omnitel 1000 km“ race start
- 10:55 AM: The parade of „Omnitel 1000 km“ race (1 parade/heat-up lap, 1 form-up lap)
- 11:00 AM: „Omnitel 1000 km“ race start (from moving position)
- 19:30 PM: Expected finish of „Omnitel 1000 km“ race and winner announcement

We will have 2 store VIP stand for watching the race. On the first floor there will be a possibility to follow the race in real time on the monitors with live view and statistics. The lottery and various games will be organised during the race with valuable gifts (visiting the team paddock being one of them). After the race all the teams, racing with „Alfa Romeo“ will be invited to „Alfa City“ to share their impressions from the race.

At 21:00 PM - closing of race event, second part of „Alfa Party“ will start.

- * To celebrate the „Alfa Romeo“ centenary, special souvenirs will be produced (t-shirts, caps, flags for cars, posters, etc.)
- * The event will be officially approved by Palanga municipality and police
- * Police escort will always follow the caravan
- * Event is organised by „Alfa Romeo“ club of Lithuania together with „Alfa Romeo“ dealer „Autobrava“
- * Big tent will be provided in case of rain.
- * Food will be served in „Alfa City“ by HBH Juozo Alaus Bravoras company during all these days.
- * Alfa city will have WC zone (WC and showers).
- * Alfa city will have a concert stage with equipment.
- * Alfa city will be visited by „Alfa Romeo“ representatives, dealer, other guests.
- * All neighbour Alfa Clubs are invited (Latvia, Estonia, Finland, Poland, Belarus, Scandinavia)

Please have these things with you: tent, raincoats and boots (in case of rain), traveller's chairs, flash lights and good mood ;)
